Jan Schebek, an influential 19th century railroad builder, constructed, among others, the monumental Schebek Palace in the center of Prague, now home to the CERGE-EI institute. Later on, the Palace was sold and the family moved to the chateau located in a quiet town called Zruč nad Sázavou.

The documentary film depicts the story of the chateau in which his family once lived. Accentuated against real historical events, the author also tries to materialize the legacy his once influential family could have impressed into this sleepy little town.
